

Software Center is available in central managed PC. You can install built-in applications and software updates through the **Software Center**.

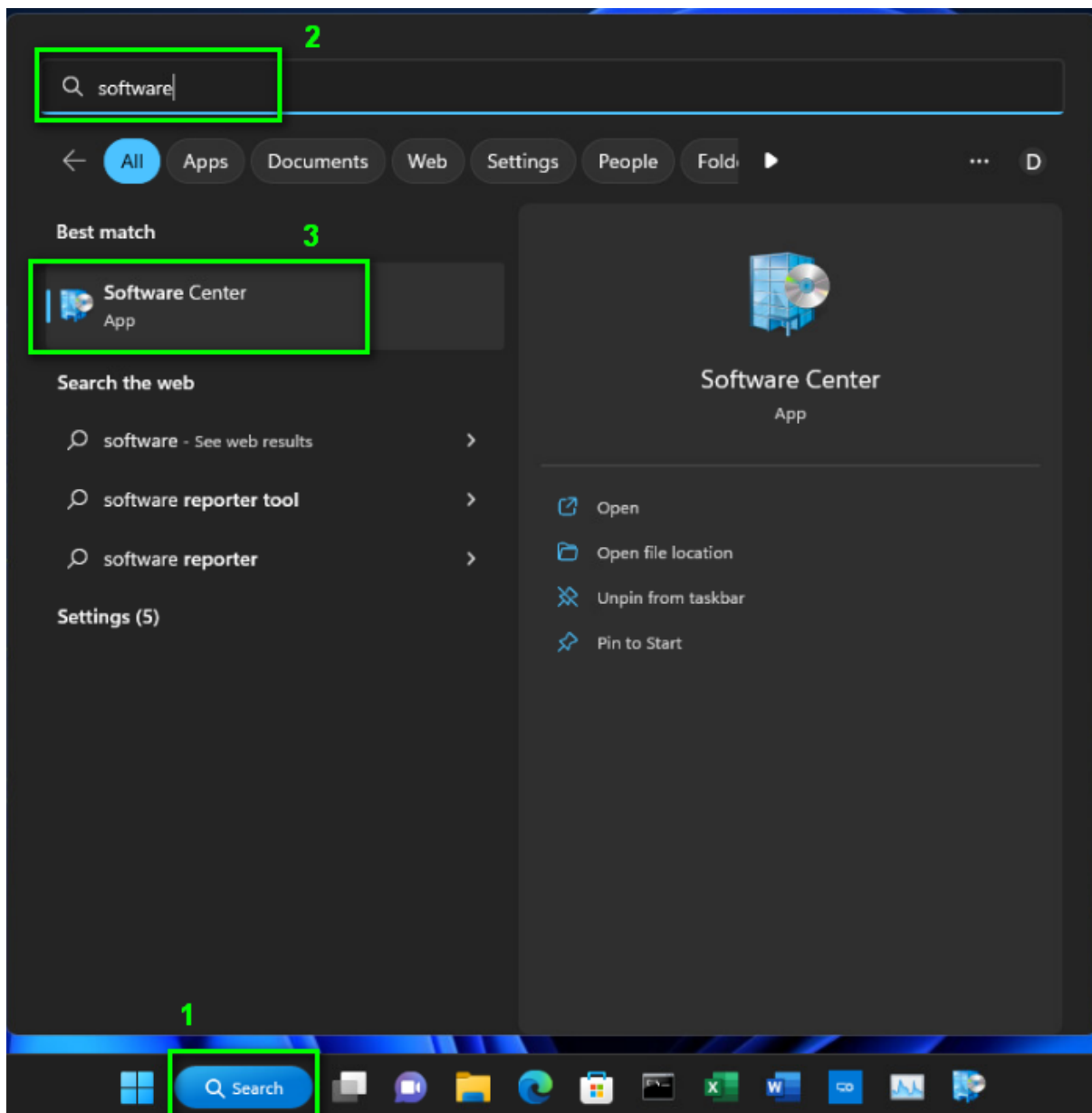
Prerequisites

- **Internet connectivity (no VPN required)**

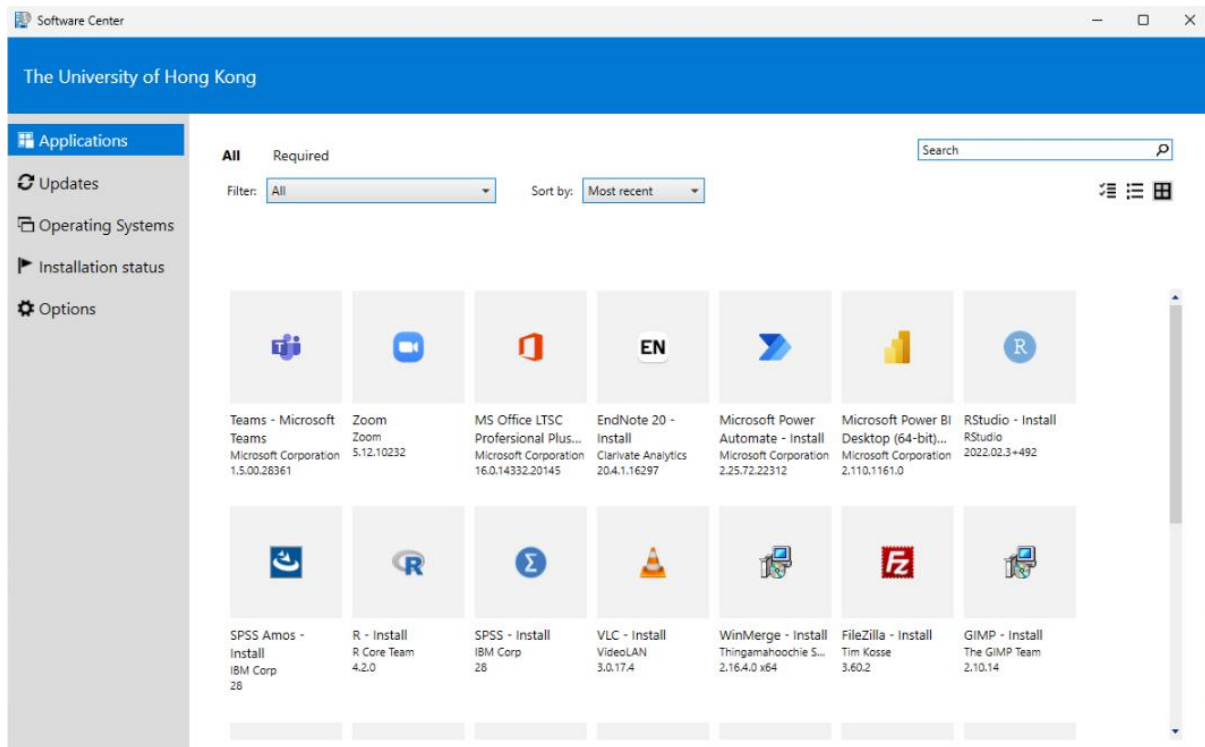
How to open Software Center

1. Use the search function and input "software ...", **Software Center** appears in Best match field.

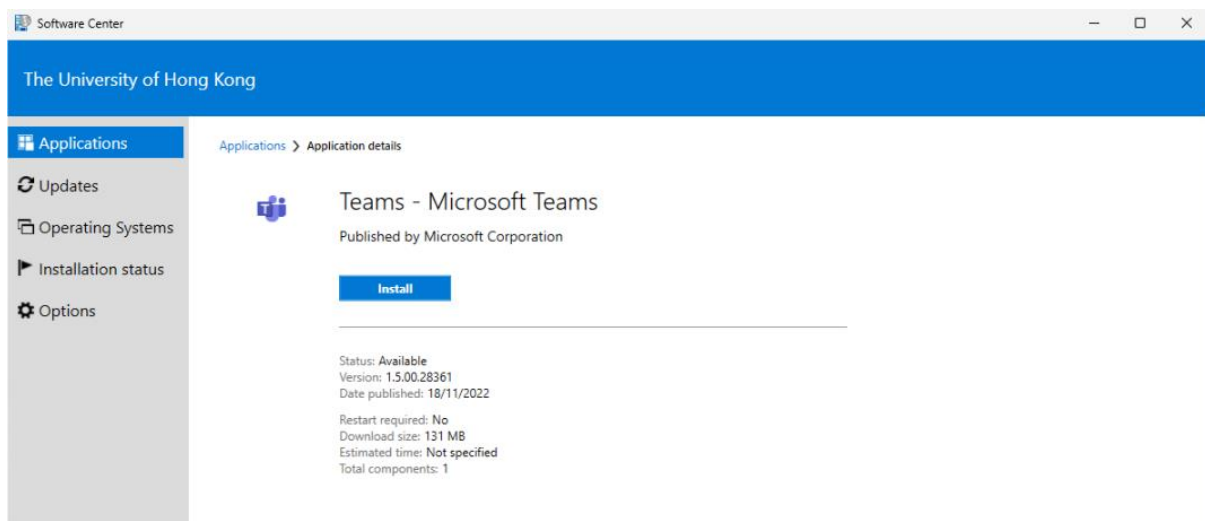


2. Click **Software Center** to launch it.



Applications


All the built-in applications are listed under **Applications**. To install application, select the desired item and click **Install** button.
